

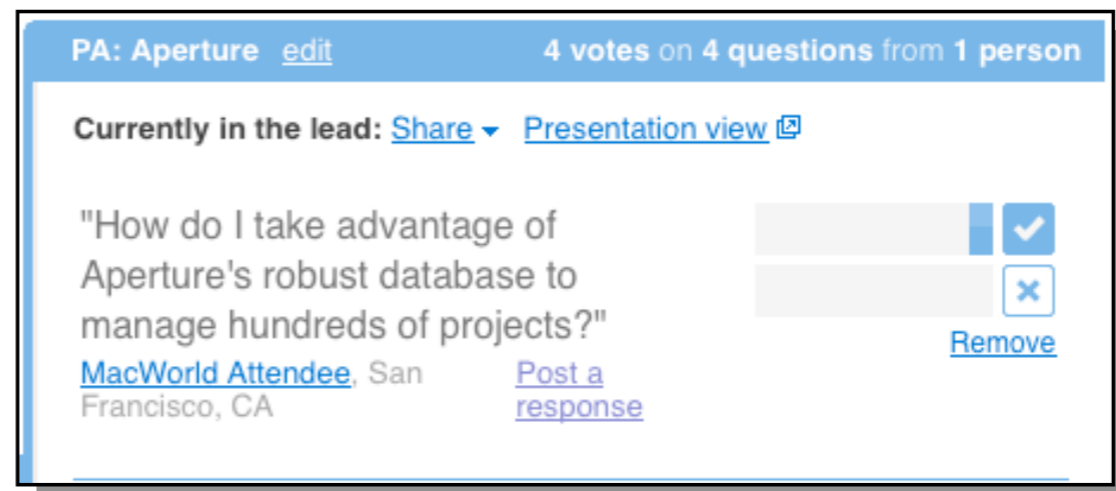
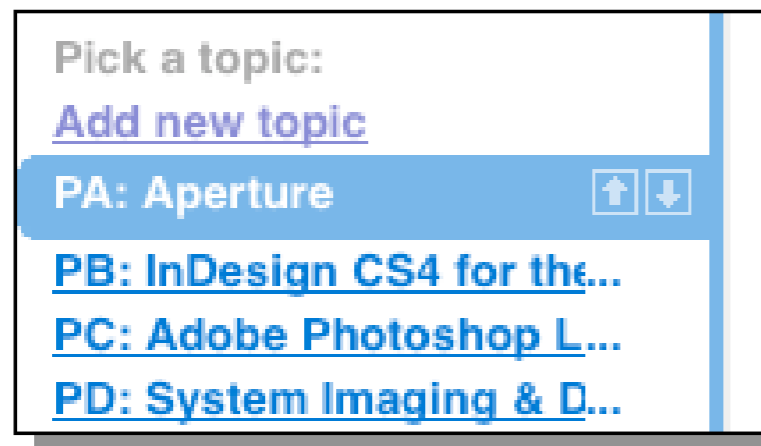

Live DVD Montage

- ***Pre-Event day Preparation***
- ***Capture the Images***
- ***Quick Edit/Select the Images***
- ***Creating the “Live” DVD Montage***

Pre-Event day Preparation

- *Prepare all Music and Graphic Images prior to the event date*
- *Begin the DVD Montage with Pre-Event day Photos*
- *Import Images to Fotomagico*
- *Able to spend more time on “Custom Timing” and “Ken Burn” effects than the “Event Day”*

Event Date

Capture the Images

- *Shoot Raw + Small Jpg*
- *In Finder Sort by “File Type” to select all the Jpgs*
- *Only import “Small Jpgs” to the desktop*

Quick Edit/Select the Images

- *Import Small Jpgs to iView Media Pro for Editing/Selection*
- *Learn to “Tag” photos and send them to PS Droplets as needed*
- *Sort all images (photos + Graphic) and do a “Batch Rename”*

Creating the “Live” DVD

- *Import Renamed Images to existing Fotomagico file*
- *Drag Music Tracks to Fotomagico*
- *Do “Select All” to the “New Images”, set all new images to 3-4 Seconds and Zoom to “Whole” Images*
- *Set all new images to “Non-Pan & Zoom”*
- *Select “Key” images and add Pan & Zoom as well as custom timing*
- *If using multiple songs, make sure each song ends on a Beat*

Web-Ready DVD Montage

- *In Fotomagico select “File>Share”*
- *Select “Web Movie”*

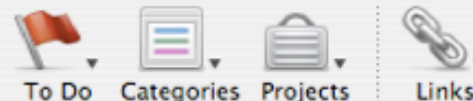
