Macintosh

- * A general purpose computer
- * A file system for storing data
- * Large screen, keyboard, mouse
- * Easy to attach peripherals
- * Syncs data to iPad/iPhone

- * Easy to carry around
- * Clipboard sized; fits in your lap
- * Touch screen

iPhone

- * Fits in my pocket
- * Makes phone calls
- * Knows where it is
- * Does not depend on Wi-Fi
