- Become aware of Xgrid and want to use it
- Building your Xgrid
 - Dedicated vs. Cycle Harvesting
 - Controller on Mac OS X
"client"
- Running demo programs
- Writing your own demo/informational programs
- Looking for projects that use your Xgrid
 - Quote from xgrid-users mailing list

UK's Primary Xgrid

- Cycle Harvesting
- 178 Macintosh computers (agents in Xgrid terms) in student labs
- 273 processors
- 538.25 GHz

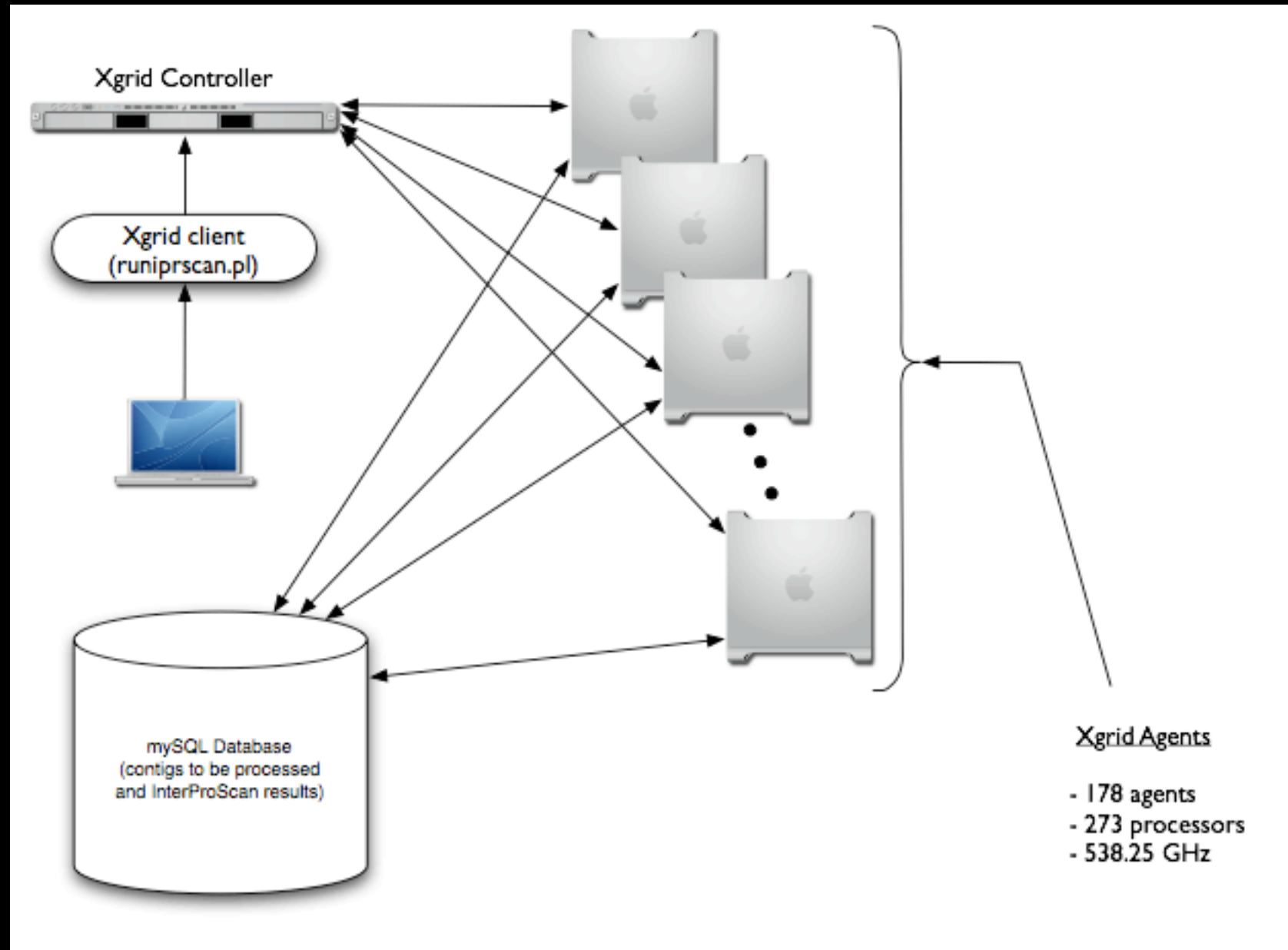

Epichloe Festucaë Genome Project

- 2 year grant to study Epichloe Festucaë (a fungus that grows on Fescue grass)
- A large portion of the project from a computing standpoint is the prediction of protein domains
- They quickly realized that with their current computing environment that their 2 year grant was going to need at least 3 years of computation.



Xgrid / InterPro Scan Setup



SENSORS and Wildfire Simulation Project



- Simulate sensors which take measurements related to wildfires
- One Xgrid job simulates one sensor
- Aids in both modeling prediction and “stress testing” server which collects data

Career Center Mock Interview Project

- Video tape students in mock interview
- Use Xgrid to compress and reformat video and then move it to a web server
- Not all grid projects involve 10s or 100s of computers - they have 4
- Goal in this XGrid wasn't just maximum performance, but shifting the workload to the free system.
- Apple's upcoming podcast producer remarkably similar in design....

Expanding Xgrid and Its Use at UK

- Purchased dedicated server and storage for Xgrid controller
- Installed Java agent on Sun machines
